INFORMATION SHEET

1 INTRODUCTION

This document describes how to disable the HD MultiCast + Importer/Exporter task scheduler from turning off the Gen4 software.

1.1 Equipment Affected

This procedure applies to all HD Multicast+ Importer/Exporters (Nautel part # NAE112B, NAE112B/01, and NAE112B/02), with software version HDMC-IPR/XPR SW 2.0.0 (Xperi Gen4 code 5.3.4).

1.2 Responsibility for Implementation of Procedure

Only qualified station maintenance personnel who are familiar with the HD Multicast+ Importer/ Exporter should perform this procedure.

1.3 Scheduling

Implement this procedure at the earliest convenience for station maintenance personnel. The transmitter system can remain "on air" during this procedure.

1.4 Manpower Requirements

It is estimated that implementing this modification will require 10 minutes to complete.

1.5 Special Tools/Test Equipment

The following are required:

• Connect a monitor (DVI input), keyboard (USB) and USB mouse to the HD Multicast+ Importer/Exporter during this procedure.

1.6 Materials

No parts or test equipment are required to complete this procedure.

1.7 Identifying Modified Assemblies/Parts

No assemblies or parts are modified by this procedure.



2 PROCEDURE

(a) Run Windows Task Scheduler (search for Task Scheduler). The screen in Figure 1 will display.
