



V1.2.0 to 2.0.1 Importer Software Upgrade Procedure

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INFORMATION SHEET

NOTES

Substantial changes have occurred in the Importer version 2.0.1 software. This requires that previous versions of Importer software be completely uninstalled prior to installing the new Version 2.0.1.

Additionally, the database structure has been significantly altered. Previous databases are no longer valid. Any service provider information or bandwidth allocations which have been modified in your Importer will be lost during the upgrade so it is essential that all current stored configurations be saved manually and then re-entered after the upgrade is completed.

The importer will not have to be re-licensed if the original licensing information was recorded. Unfortunately this information cannot be recovered from your Importer.

If this information is unavailable renew the license by running the Licence Manager application in the Ibiqity program group. See the Importer Operations-Maintenance manual for instructions.

1 Un-Installing v1.2.0 Software

- (a) Power up and log onto the Importer.
- (b) From the Windows XP Start menu, select Control Panel.
- (c) Select Add or Remove Programs.
- (d) From the list of programs:
 - Select Importer 1.2.
 - Click the Remove button.
 - Select Importer Tools 1.2.
 - Click the Remove button.
 - Select Microsoft SQL Server Desktop Engine.
 - Click the Remove button.




Figure 1: Programs to be un-installed



2 Installing v2.0.1 Importer

- (a) Copy the folder **Importer 2.0.1 Install** from the upgrade CD to the root directory of the hard drive on the Importer. The directory structure must be retained.

All of the necessary installers are included in this folder.

- (b) Importer 2.0.1 requires DirectX9. Ensure that DirectX9 is installed on your Importer by navigating to the following folder:




Figure 2: Install DirectX 9.0

→**importer2.0.1Install\installer\Directx9Install\DirectX9** (see Figure 2)

Run **dxsetup.exe**. This will either verify that DirectX9 is installed or upgrade the DirectX9 version.




Figure 3: Install DOT-NET Framework

(c) Install the Microsoft DotNet-Framework by navigating to:

→**importer2.0.1Install\installer\DotNet-Framework** (see Figure 3)
Run **dotnetfx-Framework1.1.exe**.

(d) **Restart** the Importer.






Figure 4: Install the Importer Application

- (e) Install the Importer application.
 Navigate to the following folder:

→**importer2.0.1Install\installer**
 (see Figure 4)

Run the **ImporterSetup.exe** application. This will install the Importer software.

At the end of the Importer software installation, you will be prompted to input the IP address of your Exporter. This may also be entered later, once the software is installed and run.

Do not attempt to install Importer by running the **Setup.exe** file in the Importer folder. This will result in only a partial, non-working installation.






Figure 5: Install the Importer Tools

- (f) Install the Importer Tools. Navigate to:

→**importer2.0.1\Install\installer\Importer Tools**

(see Figure 5)

Run **Setup.exe**.

At the end of the installation, you will be prompted to enter the IP Address for the WebAdmin client. Enter 127.0.0.1 to allow this administration tool to be run on the Importer.

- (g) **Configuring Two Audio Capture Clients**

Once all of the previously mentioned applications have been installed, a single audio capture client will have been installed. This is configured as SPS1. In order to create a second audio capture client for SPS2, perform the following steps:

Delete the CaptureClient shortcut from the Importer desktop.

Copy the folder **C:\Program Files\Ibiquity Digital\Importer\Importer2.0\Clients**.

Paste this to two new folders:

1. **C:\Program Files\Ibiquity Digital\Importer\Importer2.0\Clients_SPS1**

2. **C:\Program Files\Ibiquity Digital\Importer\Importer2.0\Clients_SPS2**

Each of these folders will now contain a capture client which is configured as SPS1. Enter the Clients_SPS2 folder and edit the **SPSCaptureClient.xml** file, changing both references from **sps_one** to **sps_two**.

Create appropriate shortcuts on the desktop to the capture clients in these folders.

The upgrade is complete.
