Customer Notification: NV Software Update 2.6

On October 6th, 2009 Nautel released version 2.6.

If you have been advised by our customer service department to upgrade or if you have experienced problems addressed in this software release please proceed with the download.

For Software 2.6 the information sheet to use is IS09004C

The most significant improvements with this version include:

- 10MHz alarm has enable/disable control
- Presets can be configured to force a change to another preset in the event of an audio loss
- All alarms available in the Remote IO selection list
- LOG page has a copy log button which can be used remotely to copy all logs to a text file.
- Alarm ICON state was reversed. Now shows correctly
- Date and time displays properly
- SWR Shutback threshold is now adjustable.
- HD-only operation is fully functional
- Enhancements to general HD operation for operation with higher HD carrier power
- More accurate power measurement and enhanced metering allowing display of analog and digital portions.
- Top banner power meter shows the analog RMS power in FM+HD mode. In analog and HD mode, meter shows RMS power.
- Preset power setpoint corresponds to banner power measurement display.
- Many more minor AUI updates.
